Things You Need To Know

Driving Directions to the Hotel and Parking

Hotel address: 15269 104th Ave, Surry BC V3R 1N5.

From Tsawwassen area

Follow Hwy 17, turn right onto Hwy 10. Take Hwy 10 to 152nd St, turn left. Turn right onto 104th Ave.

From the West

Take Hwy 1 East to the 152nd St exit. Turn left on 104th Ave.

From the Vancouver Airport

Take Hwy 99 South (Seattle, Ferries, Richmond City Centre). Exit onto Hwy 91 South. Take exit onto Nordel Way, which becomes 88th Ave. Follow 88th Ave and turn left onto 152nd St. From 152nd St turn right at 104th Ave.

From the East

Take Hwy 1 West to 104th Ave. Stay in left lane and cross the overpass. Remain on 104th Ave.

Parking is complimentary if you are staying at the hotel overnight.

Otherwise parking is \$10 per day. Payment is at the meter using a credit card.

General Shuttle Information

Local transportation from Abbotsford International Airport and King George Station (via Sky Train) is being arranged for peak arrival and departure times at a special rate of \$10 per person for a round trip.

For those arriving at Abbotsford International Airport, shuttles will run at peak times on March 28 and 29. You may need to wait for some time between shuttles, so please be patient. Our shuttle provider is West Wagon. If you prefer to arrange your own taxi, it will cost you approximately \$60.

Shuttles departing for Abbotsford International Airport will be available in the evening of March 30 and at peak times on March 31. The first shuttle will leave following the conclusion of the Gathering. Please confirm the time of your departure shuttle when you register at the conference. Transportation from King George Station will be arranged around peak times, a representative will be in contact.

West Wagon

A West Wagon representative will meet you at the baggage claim area at the time communicated to you by Local Arrangements. The driver will have a sign with your name on it.
